complies with European Community regulations and local laws in the selection, storage and use of chemicals. The EC regulation on chemicals and their safe use deal with Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals substances (REACH). This regulation requires all chemical substances used in our fine papers to be registered in the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) database. As a "down stream user" of these substances, accepts only chemicals that have been registered in this database. We regularly communicate to our suppliers that we only accept pre-registered substances for use in our products.

The ECHA also publishes a candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), which includes substances that may have very serious and often irreversible effects on humans and the environment: https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table
Based on the declarations submitted by our raw material suppliers in compliance with our systems for traceability of all incoming raw materials, and on our knowledge of the manufacturing process, we can confirm that some is not using any substances defined as SVHC. We continue to monitor the SVHC candidate list for any updates.
At, we have also carried out a risk assessment to guarantee a continuous supply of the chemicals that we need for our processes and have trained our personnel to understand the requirements that REACH sets for our production.


